Sexual Predator Stalking Women Near American University

NewsChannel 8, Arlington, VA, July 21, 2008 - American University is nestled in a mostly quiet residential part of Northwest Washington, where crime is infrequent. That's what makes the rash of assaults all the more unsettling.

Police say it was the same American University student victimized in the last two attacks. Investigators believe one man is responsible for all four incidents. The attacker allegedly surprises his victims from behind and gropes them. In at least one case, he tried to drag the woman behind some nearby trees. She screamed and broke free.
