My Sister Was Killed While The Police Did Nothing by David Rose

UK - The Observer - Sunday, March 11, 2007. The killings shocked the country: women murdered by ex-partners despite warnings of stalking to the police. David Rose investigates how the tragedies happened and learns of the families' search for justice.

The voices recorded by the 999 operators were full of terror. Rana Faruqui, desperately calling for help as the man who had been stalking her for years approached; Julia Pemberton, similarly pleading as her husband entered the storeroom where she was hiding. Minutes later both women were murdered by the men who had threatened their lives for months.
