Internet Harassment or Cruel Hoax?

Although the events surrounding the "MySpace suicide" took place in October 2006, this disturbing story has only recently been published in newspapers, featured on news stations and

talk shows almost daily. Megan Meier, a 13-year-old girl from Dardenne Prairie, Missouri, who suffered from depression and attention deficit disorder, made a new friend, or so she thought. "Josh" wanted to be friends, and was really nice to Megan for about a month before he suddenly turned on her. He began calling her horrible names, which he posted for others to see. In the end, Megan hanged herself. About six weeks later, her father found a message from Josh, telling the girl she was a bad person and the world would be better without her. Recently, because of Megan's death, city officials have unanimously passed a measure making online harassment a crime in Missouri City.

According to Jayne Hitchcock, founder and president of Working to Halt Online Abuse (WHOA), "What happened to her was horrible, don't get me wrong, but what needs to change is the accountability of sites such as MySpace, not creating laws that will do nothing like this one. MySpace, Yahoo, Hotmail, Facebook, etc., need to have some sort of safeguard so that fake profiles can NOT be opened up and used to demean, harass, or be forged in someone else's names. Victims/Advocates Speak Out: Wal-Mart Stops Nationwide Sales of "Stalking T-Shirt"

Back in September, a victim in North Carolina contacted her local newspaper regarding a T-shirt which read, "Some Call It Stalking, I Call It Love" being sold at Wal-Mart. After reading about the T-shirt, we forwarded our concerns to the Stalking Resource Center, contacted the newspaper reporter and drafted a letter to Wal-Mart. This was not simply an opinion, freedom of speech, or the least bit funny. Stalking is NOT love! To harass, torment, target and potentially kill someone...is not love.
