### Why Do They Blame The Victim?

The victim "could have or should have" done something different. Why "did they or didn't they" do this or that? No one ever asks to be a victim. Then why are they often blamed for being stalked, assaulted, or even worse, murdered? Some are even judged for looking or dressing a certain way. Has this ever happened to you or someone you know?

While doing a search one day, I came across a Web site which made reference to my sister, Sandy. Although it never mentioned her by name, it was more than obvious it was her. They insinuated that she did something wrong by not "changing her lifestyle or moving." Although she was most certainly forced to change her lifestyle, she felt moving would have given her stalker complete control of her life. She

knew it would have only been a matter of time for him to find her. Stalkers have obsessive behavior, they don't just give up. I have to admit, I was more than a little shocked that information which is meant to help victims, would actually blame a victim to try to make a point. Not to mention, the example and advice given, was based on completely inaccurate information. The organization was contacted, and their example was removed.

## **Advocating for Victims**

No two stalking victims or their situations are exactly the same. The onset and circumstances are equally as different. Stalking isn't just a problem for celebrities, or intimate partners. Every year, there are hundreds of non-intimate and stranger stalkings, which are not given the same attention. We are committed to bringing more national attention to these victims, by educating the public with our sister's story.

I was recently asked to speak on behalf of my sister, during several training events in Massachusetts. It is important that all victims of stalking have a voice. We want to be that voice!
