But, in light of recent abductions, we have become increasingly aware of the need to educate parents and their children about the crime of stalking. For example, the convicted sex offender who abducted Shasta and Dylan Groene, bragged about stalking them for weeks before he abducted them, and how he used night-vision goggles to learn the layout of their house. Please take a moment to read the following letter from John Walsh of America's Most Wanted...

On July 27, 1981 my son Adam was abducted and murdered. I was heartbroken and outraged. But, my rage empowered me, and with the help of many other courageous people we have come so far in protecting our children. Then in February, I was heartbroken and outraged all over again at the news that Jessica Lunsford was

murdered by a known threat to children -- a convicted sex offender. Since then, it's played out in the headlines again and again, known sex offenders committing crimes against our children.
