Feel Safe Again, Inc., a non-profit organization for victims of stalking, would like to use this month as an opportunity to educate the public about the pervasive crime that affects nearly 1.4 million Americans a year. "We are asking the community for their help in recognizing National Stalking Awareness Month," said Cheryl Darisse, founder and president.

Stalking is typically defined as a course of conduct directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person to feel fear. It is a criminal offense under the laws of all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and the federal government.

According to the U.S. Department of Justice, one in 12 women and one in 45 men will be stalked in their lifetime, for an average duration of almost two years. Seventy-six percent of female homicide victims were also stalked prior to their death, and more than half of these victims reported stalking to the police before being murdered by their stalkers.

Armed Rapist Targets Young Texas Men by Lianne Hart

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A rapist targeting young men in this refinery city has struck at least five times since April, stalking each victim in advance to make sure he's home alone, police say. The victims are in their late teens or early 20s and live with their parents. In each case the attacker has broken into the home or surprised the victim near the front door and forced him inside, Baytown Police Capt. Roger Clifford said. He has sexually assaulted the men at gunpoint or knifepoint, and has then demanded money or valuables.

"He's always been careful to make sure no one else is home when he confronts them," Clifford said. "There have been no witnesses." Reports of serial rapists targeting men are much less common than cases with female victims.
